# RAPHA MAY 2024



### PREVENTION: PHYSICAL AND EMOTIONAL SUPPORT FOR FAMILIES

Once a month, Rapha staff distributes rice to the families enrolled in our Prevention program in Cambodia. Helping families meet basic needs and fill gaps in resources is essential to Rapha's work to prevent exploitation and family separation.

This month at the rice distribution event, Rapha staff turned their attention to another type of basic need- mental health support. Vulnerable families are often impacted by poor mental health, due to untreated trauma, cyclical issues like abuse and alcoholism, and the pervasive stress caused by living in poverty. Parents and caregivers who have untreated mental health issues are less likely to create safe environments for children or to be able to protect them from trafficking or exploitation.



Through a partnership with EMDR Cambodia-an organization providing trauma therapy and training on mental health issues-parents in our Prevention program were educated about the signs and impacts of trauma. Over 100 parents were screened for symptoms of post traumatic stress disorder (PTSD) and other mental health difficulties.

Heartbreakingly, 40% of the parents screened demonstrated symptoms of PTSD. Rapha staff are working together with therapists from EMDR Cambodia to provide group and individual therapy for those individuals, to promote healing for parents and safety for children.
